Handmade pottery

With a continuous presence since the Neolithic era, **caliph-style ceramics** stand out in Andalusia, especially the style that appeared in Medina Azahara between the 9th and 11th centuries. **Nasrid pottery** is the next most significant, which originated in the pottery workshops of the hillock of Granada, where the doorway to the city was located: Fajalauza. Don't forget the geometric ornamentation that was used on most production after the 11th century in Al-Andalus (generally known **Al-Andalus ceramice**), or very specific productions such as the lustreware of Malaga pottery workshops in the 13th century.

After a considerable decline in demand during the 20th century, in recent years there has been a spectacular resurgence, and it is now one of the crafts that has best adapted to modern demands for decorative traditional products.

In **Almería** the preservation of most of its historical pottery workshops and of the most traditional collections for fire and water are noteworthy. Municipalities like Vera, Nijar, Sorbas and Albox are a clear example of the preservation of this craft.

The province of **Cádiz** has several towns where pottery work has had a presence and remains today, especially in the municipalities of Jimena and Conil de la Frontera.

With presence of Muslims, the pottery tradition in **Córdoba** underwent a radical change. Today, and thanks to the efforts of different researchers and workshops, it has been possible to recover pottery from the caliphate of Córdoba, the era of greatest splendour of Arab Spain. The importance of the pottery centre at La Rambla (one of the major centres of the country) and the purity of the pottery tradition in Lucena, are both noteworthy.

The province of **Granada** has been the home of a great pottery tradition, and despite its decline, it currently has a large production for decorative purposes, and very significant pieces have been recovered from the old Granada pottery workshops, such as the Accitana jug (from Guadix), traditional tiles and polychrome clay figures.

In the province of **Huelva**, there has historically been a longstanding tradition of pottery and ceramics, as demonstrated by the excellent collections exhibited in the different museums in the capital. Note that the basic raw material used in this province is white clay from Trigueros and its surroundings.

Jaén is one of the Andalusian provinces where these types of crafts stand out the most, with important ceramics centres in Alcalá la Real, Aldeaquemada, Andújar, Arjonilla, Bailén, Baeza, Cazorla, Puerta de Segura, Marmolejo, Puente de Genave, Santa Elena, Siles, Torredelcampo and Úbeda.

In modern **Málaga**, the legacy of traditional pottery workshops is combined with the creative pottery which has been incorporated by new craftsmen.

The city of **Seville** has one of the greatest traditions of Spanish tin-glazed polychrome ceramics, which rose to splendour in the 16th-18th centuries, and has been taken up again recently in various workshops of the capital and nearby villages.

Transforming clay into art, they extract clay from the nearby clay-pits and take it to the potter's wheel for the first stage of modelling. They then dry it in the sun so the clay has enough consistency not to warp. Once hardened, it is covered with slip (white clay) and again left to dry, before passing into the hands of the artists who use their paintbrushes to create their characteristic designs of cockerels and bulls, floral patterns, and more.

Once the painting process is complete, the pieces are glazed and placed in the kiln, where they are fired at a high temperature.

Alfajar



Alfajar is a family company that was founded in 1994 in Málaga.

Pieces of stoneware, fire clay and other ceramics, crafted used traditional techniques and fired at a high temperature (1,250 °C). Each piece is individually finished, making it a one-of-a-kind work, wich is signed by its creator. The shape and form of each piece is inspired by traditional vessels made by the various cultures that have populated the Mediterranean region: Etruscan, Iberian, Mycenaean, Muslim, Greek and Roman.

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Alfarería Los Puntas

Los Puntas has carefully kept alive the entire process of making traditional pottery, working on a potter's wheel located below ground level - a chraracteristic unique to the potteries of Albox - and firing in an Arabic kiln dating from the 8th century, designated Historical Artistic Heritage status. This traditional pottery dates back to the 8th century, preserving the techniques introduced by the Muslims into the Mediterranean area of the Iberian Peninsula.

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

The tiles are fired at 980 degrees in an electric kiln (glazed tiles of 10 x 10 cm and rustic tiles of 15 x 15 cm) and the techniques used are mayólica (tin-glazing), onglaze and cuerda seca ('dry cord').

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

Process of decoration using screen-printing, with each colour applied by hand. All pieces are hand-finished with a paintbrush, so that each tile is unique. Also, manufacture of tiles in non-uniform shades of white and in solid colour washes, finished with brushstrokes, all painted by hand with an artisanal finish that has been characteristic of the workshop since 1982.





Torres Ferreras is a family pottery studio in La Rambla, a place known as the "Potters' Village". The company's purpose is to unite the traditional and rustic pottery with the functional, smart and newly-designed ceramics. They introduced the high fired stoneware into the traditional ceramics from La Rambla.

The fact that all the pieces are handmade on the potter's wheel and decorated by hand, together with the different characteristics and effects of their homemade glazes, make all of them different and unique, even if they belong to the same decorative line.

Torres Ferreras' stoneware is safe for oven, dishwasher and microwave and it can perfectly store products like salt, vinegar or oil without the leaking or rusting that these products usually provoke in traditional clay due to its composition. Besides, all the pieces are lead-free. They also make limited editions and personalized orders.


Cerámica Veronica is a handicraft pottery workshop. We only work the oldest and most durable techniques. We have very good pictorial quality so we can paint any tile or decorative object with your favourite drawing. We paint from the simplest decorations such as numbers, posters and borders, to those more elaborated such as portraits, religious images and landscapes.

I often use the technique of the eighteenth century, that is, painting using a brush on the uncooked enamel with the purest oxides. When baked in the oven at 1000°C, oxides (colours) and enamel (which covers and polishes the mud) are also baked simultaneously for perfect blending, thus making them resistant to external elements and cleaning and with a high quality finishing.


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
