

PROLOGUE

Andalusia is the southernmost region of Spain. It forms a bonding bridge between two continents, Europe and Africa, and a meeting point for the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean.

The Andalusian region has the privilege of a communications network that makes it an easy-to-reach destination: an extensive network of roads, dual carriageways and motorways; two high speed rail lines that link the centre of Andalusia with Madrid, the Spanish capital city; and an important provision of modern airports that connect Andalusia with the main Spanish, European and international capitals and cities. It is a land of contrasts that combines impressively rich nature and scenery: the high peaks of Sierra Nevada, on which to ski; natural spaces and parks like Grazalema and the Sierra de las Nieves or Sierra de Cazorla hills; the emblematic Doñana National Park or the volcanic deserts of Tabernas in Almería.

Edging the region, the coastline of Andalusia extends along more than 800 kilometres and includes many stretches of beautiful beaches at which to enjoy nautical and maritime life which are, without a doubt, another stunning natural environment with their very own personality.

All these attractions boast an enviable climate all year round: Andalusia is the sunniest region in Spain and a large proportion of the region enjoys more than 2,800 hours of sunshine per year and has an average annual temperature of 16 degrees Celsius. Furthermore, the region has an extensive history behind it. Andalusia has been a cradle of civilisation and the scene of coexistence of different cultures which have left behind an immense artistic legacy. Heritage sites include Granada's Alhambra, Seville's Giralda and the city's historical centre and Cordoba's Mosque.

There are also many museums and cultural spaces such as the Málaga Picasso Museum, Seville Fine Arts Museum, Málaga Thyssen Museum and the Andalusian Centre of Flamenco in Jerez de la Frontera.


